They are said to give you full sentience, and the ability to feel and to love just like real women used to, back on Earth.

These supplies landed somewhere on this planet, and have yet to be found. It is rumored that there are prototype Maiden Circuits among the lost supplies from the Mesopotamia.

Lost Maiden Circuits... The idea grips Tiger's mind, she stands up straight and looks at you with an intense burning gaze filled with a mixture of excitement and desperation. Tell me everything you know about them. **Everything!**

Robotman

I'm taken aback by your sudden interest and intense focus on the Maiden Circuits, but happy to know that at least someone else is finally interested too.

Well, I have actually just told you almost everything I know about the jettisoned supplies from the Mesopotamia, and the lost Maiden Circuits. The only other thing to tell is that I was just headed out west of Japoness today to look for another possible site. We can go right now, if you are able to leave your post. Will you be telling Luchs and Panther that you will be leaving for a couple of days?

Tiger nods, her smile grows wider.

I will be telling them, I am their leader for a reason, I will make sure they are well supplied and have everything they need. In the meantime, I have a small request of you, could you tell me your name...?

Robotman

I laugh slightly, embarrassed that I forgot to introduce myself.

Yes, of course, my name is Mike. I'll follow you while you let Luchs and Panther know that you're leaving for a couple of days, and then we can head off west to the place I showed you on my map.

Tiger nods and walks off, she will make sure Luchs and Panther are well cared for in her absence, and then, after a short while she returns to you.

Mike, ready to go?

Robotman

I watch you bid a farewell to Luchs and Panther. They seem little more than annoyed that they will have to take over your area of the Japoness gates for guard duty. They look at me with disdain because I am a citizen of Japoness. But I try to remember that my mission is for the good of all marionettes like them.

Yes, Tiger, I'm ready. Let's start walking down the road until we reach that big cedar tree. Then if we turn directly north and walk halfway to the river, we'll find my stashed dagger and shield.

Do you... know the name of this Marionette? *Tiger looks genuinely surprised and curious, you can tell that the story you told her has taken her attention and that she is extremely interested in this beautiful Marionette you spoke of.*

Robotman

Unbeknownst to me, I have just described exactly what happened to you and to your Maiden Circuit, when your owner and master Faust turned villainous and rejected you.

No, Tiger, I just heard the rumor. But stories like that are exactly why I think it is so important to find these jettisoned supply sites, and to search for any Maiden Circuits they may have.

Tiger stops in her tracks, a look of sudden realization flashes across her face, she turns to you and walks right up to you, she looks you straight in the eyes, her pupils dilate, her hair seems to flutter in an invisible breeze for a moment, and you feel an aura of almost otherworldly beauty and a

Robotman

I stand, held in your arms, flabbergasted and momentarily confused.

Wait... not only is that sad story true... but that poor marionette... is you?!

Oh, Tiger, that's so awful for you to have to deal with! But that means that...

That means that Faust is the one who mistreated you. And if we find a Maiden Circuit and install it in you, Faust will need to train it with his love for you.

She nods, her eyes grow wide for a moment in surprise, the realization suddenly coming to her. Is that... She gulps, tears start to well up in her eyes once again and her voice is almost barely a whisper as she utters what might be the most important words of her life. That's how it must work, Tiger. You are dedicated to Faust - both in your programming and in your role as the leader of the Saber Dolls. And you still hold out hope that your love for him will change him for the better.

But does Faust see you in the same way? Does he view you as a partner, or as a mere servant and soldier?

Then... She takes a deep breath to calm down, the rage leaving her, but being replaced immediately by a look of determination.

Then I will reach him, at all costs.

She says with renewed vigor and starts walking again, a small smile on her face, she takes your hand and holds it tightly against her chest.

Robotman

I smile at your determination.

Your steely resolve is something I admire about you Saber Dolls, Tiger. I told you that my next door neighbor in Japoness is a man named Otaru. His three marionettes are rather flighty and vapid, to be honest. They get on my nerves with their constant chatter.

But ever since you, Luchs, and Panther came to guard the Japoness gates, I've watched you from afar, and I have wished that I could meet a rational, sane marionette like one of you.

Tiger smiles deeply at the compliment, a hint of sadness passing through her eyes, there is a brief flash of anger and a slight pain in her eyes that she quickly suppresses, but then a light seems to appear in her eyes, as if someone had just lit a candle in a dark room, hope. She starts to walk faster, a certain spring in her steps and a renewed vigor in her actions. She gives your hand a slight squeeze in gratitude for what you just said.

we walk together through the fields and brush outside of Japoness for a few hours, talking about the current political situation, and about the history of this planet Terra II. We both find that we are not so different, as a human man from Japoness and a robot Marionette that serves the leader of Gartland.

I think that since Marionettes were built for humans, and built to look like women, it's natural that your programming would allow you to "feel" and to "desire" in your own ways those same things that humans want.
